How to Invalidate God's Word (Mark 7:9-23)

- I. REJECT God's Word by elevating tradition over truth.
 - A. The statement of Scripture: Exodus 20:12
 - 1. Honor your father and mother.
 - a. Respect their personhood and position.
 - b. Respond to their needs in their old age.
 - B. The tradition of the elders. (Pharisees)
 - 1. Corban.
 - a. A gift dedicated to God; an offering.
 - b. A loophole to get out of the commandment.
- II. REPLACE God's Word by making experience the final authority.
 - A. Handing down to the next generation.
 - 1. The way we've always done it.
 - B. Practicing a superiority over others.
 - 1. The Pharisee and the publican. (Luke 18:9-14)
 - C. Turning the Gospel into a system of works righteousness.
 - 1. Woe to them! (Matthew 23:13-15)
- III. REWRITE God's Word by emphasizing outward acts over inward motivations.
 - A. The emphasis of man.
 - 1. Outward appearance. (I Samuel 16:7a) (James 2:1-4)
 - B. The emphasis of God.
 - 1. The heart. (Jeremiah 17:9) (I Samuel 16:7b)
 - 2. The sinful state. (Romans 3:23; 6:23a) (John 2:23-25)
 - 3. The gospel of grace. (Romans 6:23b) (Ephesians 2)
