The Traditions of Men (Mark 7:1-8)

- I. Legalism begins where God's Word ends.
 - A. The Ten Commandments/The Law of Moses/Pentateuch.
 - B. Scribes/Oral Law/Tradition of the Elders.
 - C. Halakhah: Oral teachings of the Rabbi.
 - D. 3rd Century AD: Mishnah
- II. Distortion of the Law (Word) of God.
 - A. The living word becomes dead to the hearers. (Hebrews 4:12)
 - B. The living word is replaced by what man wants to hear. (2 Timothy 4:1-8)
 - C. The living word is misquoted or misrepresented. (Genesis 3) (I Timothy 6:10)

III. Expressions of False piety.

- A. Supported by human precepts.
 - 1. The scribes and Pharisees. (Matthew 23:1-12)
 - 2. The Judaizers. (Galatians)
 - 3. The current "religious" culture. (James 1:26-27)
- B. Devoid of biblical authority.
 - 1. Prophets: "Thus saith the Lord."
 - 2. Jesus: "But I say."
 - 3. The Scriptures: I Corinthians 15; 2 Timothy 3:16,17; 2 Peter 1:19-21.
- C. Outwardly focused but inwardly dead.
 - 1. Their worship is worthless.
 - 2. They neglect the commandment of God.
 - a. Love the Lord with all your heart, mind, soul; love one another as yourself.
 - 3. They hold to the traditions of men.
