The Return of Christ (Mark 13:24-37)

- I. The return of Christ follows the Abomination of Desolation. (v. 14)
 - A. Predicted in Daniel. (9:27; 11:31; 12:11)
 - B. Performed by Antiochus IV Epiphanes. (175-165 BC)
 - C. Presented by the Antichrist. (2 Thessalonians 2:3,4) (Revelation 13:1,5)
