Four Questions and Two Warnings (Mark 12:13-44)

FOUR QUESTIONS

- I. The question of AUTHORITY. (Vss. 13-17)
 - A. Asked by the religious (Pharisees) and political (Herodians) leaders.
 - B. Is paying the poll tax to Caesar legal?
 - C. All authority comes from God. (Romans 13)
- II. The question of RESURRECTION. (Vss. 18-27)
 - A. Asked by the Sadducees who were wealthy, arrogant priests.
 - 1. Denied the resurrection, the existence of the soul, life after death, a final judgement, angels and demons. (Acts 23:8)
 - 2. They only accepted the Law of Moses: Genesis-Deuteronomy.
 - B. What about marriage in the afterlife?
 - C. No marriage in the afterlife; God is the God of the living. (Exodus 3:6, 15-16; Romans 14:8,9)
- III. The question of PRIORITY. (Vss. 28-34)
 - A. Asked by a scribe who was an expert in the
 - B. Which of God's commands is the greatest?
 - C. Jesus quotes the SHEMA (Deuteronomy 6:4-5 and Leviticus 19:18)
- IV. The question of MESSIAHSHIP. (Vss. 35-37)
 - A. The counter question by Jesus.
 - B. Psalm 110:1 describes the Messiah as David's Lord.
 - C. Jesus fulfills both David's son AND David's Lord.
 - 1. David's son (Matthew 1:1, John 7:41-42)
 - 2. David's Lord: God in flesh! (Isaiah 7:14, Matt. 1:18-25, Luke 1:26-38)



TWO WARNINGS

- I. Beware of the PRIDE OF THE SCRIBES. (Vss. 38-40)
 - A. They do everything to be seen by men.
 - B. They always have a sense of entitlement.
- II. Beware of the PRIDE OF THE RICH. (Vss. 41-44)
 - A. They give to be seen by men.
 - B. They give out of their abundance.
 - 1. Portion vs. Proportion
